SLJ offers bus transportation for all students in Pensacola and many outlying areas as part of the student scholarship and tuition fees. While we do not promise door to door service, we do our best to come as close to the house as possible. Students will not be allowed to be picked up or dropped off at unauthorized stops. Parents must be available to receive their child at the appointed stop.

After School Program is now available!

The after school program is available for students in K5 thru 8th grade from 3:00 PM to 5:30 PM at a cost of \$85.00 per month for the first child and \$25.00 for each additional child in the same family. After School is not included in the regular scholarship or student tuition. The After School Program will include tutoring, playtime, snacks and transportation. Students will be required to complete all homework before playtime.

Summer School is now available!

SLJ offers five weeks of summer school for a cost of \$375.00 per student. We will provide a summer of fun and learning concentrating

on reading, writing and math for Grades 1st - 8th. The BJP Summer Vacation Station Curriculum will be used to give added help in weak areas and prepare students for the next grade level. To be assured of a summer school seat, please make arrangements in May. Summer classes are scheduled from June 20th thru July 22nd. Hours 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM.

Summer Camp is also available!

Summer Camp will be training for students who are involved in extra-curricular activities, such as Basketball, Cheerleaders, Choir, Dance and Weight Lifting.

OUR MISSION

S. L. Jones (SLJ) offers a top quality Christian education in a warm, nurturing and friendly atmosphere. Our mission is to work with parents and guardians to educate their children with a superior, quality education God's Way. Our goal is to develop students with a strong Christian character, cultivate productive citizens, provide applicable life skills and graduate a well rounded student prepared for college and will be a benefit to our community and nation. SLJ utilizes the Bob Jones Press (BJP) Christian Curriculum exclusively.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The general tuition at SLJ is \$706 per month per child based on a 10 month period pay scale. To help cover the cost, we accept two types of scholarships: (1) Students who have been a Florida resident for one year, attended a public school and have a current IEP may be eligible for the John McKay Scholarship. Learn more at www.floridaschoolchoice.org. (2) Students who are eligible for free or reduced lunch may qualify for the Step up for Students Scholarship (SUFS). Learn more at www.stepupforstudents.org. Scholarships

will cover tuition, books, bus transportation, and the national achievement test. Lastly, we offer family affordable tuition for Non-scholarship students. Financial aid is available for all Non-scholarship students, however, a \$100.00 Non-refundable registration fee is required to apply for financial aid. Financial aid will be granted according to family income, however, the minimum **Monthly tuition will be \$310.00 per month, per student and must be paid in advance starting before July 30th.**

HOW DOES A STUDENT ENROLL?

Enrollment is easy and can be done through an appointment or walk-in at our front office. To enroll, you will need proof of identification, proof of income, withdrawal sheet from the previous school, report card, transcript (Grades 9th-12th), lastly, you will need SSNs for both Parent and Student. Students must be approved for the John McKay scholarship, or have a commitment letter from the Step up for Students (SUFS) scholarship or have the **full \$310.00 student tuition fee** paid prior to enrollment. Children enrolling in the K5 program must turn "5" years of age before September 1st.

WHEN DOES SCHOOL BEGIN?

Orientation and Final Registration Day for K5 thru 7th Grade will be Thursday, August 18th from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Orientation and Final Registration Day for 8th thru 12th Grade will be Friday, August 19th from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM.

The first day of the 2011-2012 school year is Monday, August 22nd. Regular school hours are 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. All dates are tentative and subject to change.

Orientation is mandatory for all students and parents. At least one parent/guardian must attend for all students.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS are required for ALL students.
