SLJ offers transportation for all students in Pensacola and many outly-



ing areas as part of the student scholarship and tuition fees. While we do not promise door to door service, we do our best to come as close to the house as possible. Students will not be allowed to be picked up or dropped off at unauthorized stops. Parents must be available to receive their child at the appointed stop.

After School Program will be available for students in VPK thru 8th grade from 3:00 PM to 6:30 PM . For more information please call the office and come in to sign up. After School is not included in the regular scholarship or student tuition. The After School Program will include tutoring, playtime, snacks and transportation. Students will be required to complete all homework before playtime.

SLJ offers four weeks of summer school for a cost of \$200.00 per student. We will provide a summer of fun and learning concentrating on

reading, writing and math. The BJP Summer Vacation Station Curriculum will be used to give added help in areas and prepare students for the next grade level. To be assured of a summer school seat, please make arrangements in May. Summer classes are scheduled from June thru July. Hours 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Transportation can be provided for an extra \$25 per family for the month.

**Our CAPS office** is available to offer special services for (1) Specific Learning Disability, (2) Emotional/Behavioral Disability (3) Referrals on Speech Impaired. Sign up when you enroll your child with Mrs. Reed.

## HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

**Cost is Free to qualified scholarship students.** The general tuition at SLJ is \$764 per month per child based on a 10 month period pay scale. However, (1) Students who have been a Florida resident for one year, attended a public school and have a current IEP or 504 plan may be awarded a John McKay Scholarship, and attend SLJ Free.. **Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK)** VPK offers your child a jumpstart on their education and is Free to all four year olds in Escambia County. Eligible children must be four years of age on or before September 1st. Apply online at: <https://vpkcp.floridaearlylearning.com>.

**Approved SUFS & McKay scholarships** will cover tuition, books, transportation, and the national achievement test. Lastly, we offer family affordable tuition for non-scholarship students. Financial aid is available for all non-scholarship students, however, a \$100.00 non-refundable registration fee is required to apply for financial aid. Financial aid will be granted according to family income, however, the minimum monthly tuition will be \$317.00 per month, per student and must be paid in advance starting before July 30th.

## HOW DOES A STUDENT ENROLL?

Enrollment is easy and can be done through an appointment or walk-in at our front office. To enroll, you will need proof of identification, proof of income, withdrawal sheet from the previous school, report card, and transcript (grades 9th-12th) only, lastly, you will need SSNs for both parent and student. Students must be approved for the John McKay scholarship, or have a commitment letter from the Step Up For Students (SUFS) scholarship or have the full \$317.00 student tuition fee paid prior to enrollment. Children enrolling in the K-5 program must turn "5" years of age before September 1st.

## WHEN DOES SCHOOL BEGIN?

Orientation and Final Registration Day for VPK thru 12th Grade will be Thursday., August 8, 2019 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM.

The first day of the 2019-2020 school year is Monday, August 12, 2019. Regular school hours are 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. All dates and time are tentative and subject to change.

Orientation is mandatory for ALL students and parents. At least one parent/guardian must attend for all students.

**SCHOOL UNIFORMS** are required for ALL students.

**Breakfast and Lunch** is served daily.
